PRESIDENT'S REPORT: During the month of February there were 24,881 visitors on campus.

We have completed casing down to the hot water source, which is in excess of 1,100 feet and will continue with an eight-inch hole on our geothermal well. At the present time the water temperature is between 104° and 105°. We have had a great deal of interest this year in the legislature on our geothermal well and several of the legislator's have asked that we assist their local school districts in planning similar projects.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: House Bill #280 which would exempt C.S.I. from the 1% Initiative and provide for the continuation of receipt of liquor funds has passed the House by a 59 to 7 vote, it must still pass the Senate. This would allow the College to levy up to eight mills of property tax, and if necessary an override levy would be possible with a simple majority.
